

WEEK Weekly #1 - 1/6/2000

The show starts with so much pyrotechnics as Jim Ross and Don West introduce the hottest new wrestling program, broadcasting in all 50 states, the WEEK Weekly, the only day of the week where anything can happen.

Trevor Lee interrupts the opening festivities to tell the crowd that they should be thanking him for this show being on the air. He says without his experience, knowledge and money this company never would have started in the first place. His ultimate proof of this is with the signing he made, without any notice made to Paramount, and Lee argues it is the biggest of them all, Lou Thesz. Thesz comes out with his version of the NWA title around his waist and stands beside Lee. Lee made a deal that he'd get 30% of Thesz's earnings in exchange for his support and backing. Lee also makes it known that the belt Thesz holds is the Real Pro-Wrestling World Heavyweight Championship and that it is the most prestigious belt anywhere on the globe.

Lee continues to gloat until 'Hacksaw' Butch Reed comes out and demands answers for the already seeming favoritism in the company already. Lee says all of this is above water and will prove of no such favoritism as he sets up a match he states will be 100% clean, himself and Thesz and Reed with a partner of his choosing, with Lee saying he is being nice by allowing him to make his choice for a partner.

Lee makes the caveat though that if he can't find a partner in time for the main event tag match, he will be seen as breaking his contract and will be severely fined. Lee smiles and walks off with Thesz.

Commercial break

Rusher Kimura def. Yuki Iino (9:24)

A good honest hard hitting affair which sees Kimura get the win with a double arm suplex, the two men shake hands afterward.

Picture-in-picture during the middle of the match occurs with Butch Reed looking backstage to find a suitable partner.

Commercial Break

Vignette for the last disciple of God, Nathan Frazer. He states his arrival to the kingdom of WEEK will be imminent.

Reed continues to look for a partner, but the only wrestlers he can find are so strange that he doesn't want to extend the hand to them. He sees Madcap Moss cracking a joke to a disgruntled PAC, Bull Curry looking very hairy and Gypsy Joe practicing his fist grinding technique with fellow old men MVP and Solar.

Eventually he walks into a room with Latin Lover, where he is surrounded by a gaggle of women. Reed, seeing this as the best option of the litter, asks him if he'd want to be his tag partner and Latin Lover accepts!

The Filthy Animals consisting of Animal Hamiguchi, The Cobra, Dragon Lee & Gorilla Makabe come out. As they make their way to the ring, a video is played going over the life and times of this group, we see them training, doing meet-n-greets & drinking together. They're a group of all around up-standing and fun-loving fellas.

The Cobra & Dragon Lee def. Some jobbers (3:06)

Cobra and Lee show off their aerial and fast-paced offense, getting the crowd HOT. Cobra wins with a cobra twist with Dragon hitting a tope suicida to the other jobber on the outside.

Commercial break

Trevor Lee comes up to Reed to tell him he actually found himself a second tag team partner that was too perfect to pass up, so now Reed will have to do the same thing. Lee stresses that there isn't much time left until the main event which could spell trouble for him.

Jim Londos makes his way to the ring and cuts a promo on how he found two masters of their craft in the same vein as him in catch wrestling. Akebono in Sumo and Electroshock in MMA, they are the Top Class.

Jim Londos def. TAKA Michinoku (5:32)

TAKA puts in a valiant performance but is overwhelmed by Londos' masterful prowess and wins via airplane spin and is knocked out.

A fan with a Jim Londos shirt runs in to celebrate with Top Class, they look bewildered as he is taken by security, despite desperate attempts to escape their grasps, the fan is subdued away from the ring and the arena.

Commercial Break

Coming back from the break, TAKA is still motionless in the ring as Butch Reed's music hits and comes out with Latin Lover. He slaps TAKA awake and forces him to be their third team member. TAKA has no choice but to agree out of fear of what would happen to him if he didn't.

Lee and Thesz arrive and Lee reiterates how perfect his 2nd partner is as 'Mr Perfect' Curt Hennig comes out. Like Thesz, Hennig has made a deal with Lee.

Butch Reed, Latin Lover & TAKA Michinoku def. Lou Thesz, Mr. Perfect & Trevor Lee by DQ (16:37)

The first third of the match sees the heels continue the onslaught on TAKA. Eventually Latin Lover and Butch Reed get hot tags in pushing Thesz and Hennig into a corner, forcing Lee on his own with Reed. After a combination of punches, Lee low blows Reed as a desperate attempt to get out of harm's way, losing his team the match.

The faces try to get after Lee, but Thesz and Hennig shield him up the ramp. The show ends with Reed, Latin Lover & TAKA staring the other three men down.
