Cold Open with Bull Curry wandering around the arena with no supervision running amok. Officials try to subdue him but nothing works until Madcap Moss of all people runs out with Goldust & PAC behind him, calming the beast by telling him jokes. This seems to work as Curry seems to calm down.

We are welcomed to the WEEK Weekly, by Jim Ross and Don West. Ross says what we just witnessed was proof that this is the only day of the week where anything can happen.

MVP along with Gypsy Joe & Solar stroll out and officially dub themselves the Old Syndicate. Despite their elder statuses, they view themselves as the toughest and roughest on the roster and will do anything to prove that.

Gypsy Joe & Solar def. some jobbers (4:22)

Joe shows off his brutality while Solar shows off his llave credentials, putting some twinks into their place.

Jim Londos confidently enters the ring as the Old Syndicate celebrates and tells Solar straight up that he is too good to be associated with these other two old chumps and invites him to Top Class. Solar puts his thinking face on and ponders this question to the chagrin of MVP and Gypsy Joe.

As Londos leaves and greets the fans up the entrance ramp, one gets very touchy with him falling over the barricade as Londos moves to the stage.

Commercial Break

Rusher Kimura walks to the ring for his scheduled contest, but before his opponent comes out, Trevor Lee makes his first appearance of the night to bring some announcements. First, Kimura's opponent, Rambo, has also made a deal with Lee and will now be a part of his crew. Second, he begins talking about the planned main event, but before he can Butch Reed comes out with a mic to interrupt.

Reed demands a match against either one of his three opponents last week, but specifically Lou Thesz. Lee tries to create distance between himself and Reed and makes an appeal to him by saying he's too big off a star to have that kind of match on free TV. Lee grins and says he has an idea that will show his fairness however. Lou Thesz will put his Real Pro-Wrestling World Heavyweight title on the line TONIGHT against... TAKA Michinoku.

Lee, happy with his choice, walks down with Rambo for his match.

Rusher Kimura def. Rambo (8:28)

Reed finds himself in the corner of Kimura in order to keep an eye out on Lee. With Lee neutralized on the outside, Kimura picks up the win via a piledriver.

Commercial break

Latin Lover is backstage being sexy and awesome when he is informed he is in a tag match tonight against Diablo & Ueda. When he asks who he is paired up with he is met with a shrug. No one knows who he is teaming with aside from Trevor Lee.

Show cuts to Morbius already in the ring where he is plugging the Prime beverage. He is not sponsored in any way, he just really enjoys the taste. He gets booed profusely causing him to CRASH OUT at the crowd. During his fit of rage The Filthy Animals come out to the chagrin of Morbius. They take like 5 minutes just greeting the audience before standing face to face with Morbius, he asks why they are out here but before any of them can answer, Morbius spits Prime at Animal Hamiguchi. The two start to brawl which leads to a match between them being authorized with a ref coming out.

Animal Hamiguchi def. Morbius (6:32)

The two punch each other around the ring for most of the match, the rest of the Filthy Animals head to the back to avert any danger on their end. It ends via a wind-up punch from Hamiguchi to Morbius.

Hamiguchi celebrates his win, as he tries to go through the curtain to the back though, tragedy strikes. Goldust obstructs him pushing him back out to the ramp and sprays magical dust at his face, the 2nd projectile aimed at him in one day. Unlike the Prime though, this dust seemingly causes major damage. Hamiguchi holds his face in agony as Goldust attacks him and it only gets worse as Diablo & Ueda also come out to make it a three on one assault. The Filthy Animals try to make the save but Ueda stops them with his kendo stick.

Latin Lover then comes out neutralizing Ueda and Diablo allows the Filthy Animals to get rid of Goldust. Hamiguchi is stretchered out while Latin Lover & Ueda and Diablo are in the ring. Lover waits for his partner to come out but his opponents continue attacking him before that happens.

Another vignette plays for 'The Last Disciple of God' Nathan Frazier where he visits Mount Sanai and says he will bring his commandments to WEEK.

Back in the ring, Lover is still being beaten on when Bad Medicine begins to blast throughout the arena. Dr. Wagner Jr. appears but is in no rush to save Latin Lover, instead he emotes and aura farms during his entrance. The bell rings when he finally gets to the ring.

El Hijo de Diablo & Umanusuke Ueda def. Dr. Wagner Jr. & Latin Lover (14:08)

Latin Lover finds himself in continuous trouble with his opponents constantly tagging in and out, keeping him on their side of the ring. Wagner does not do much to rally Latin Lover or the crowd. When Wagner eventually tags in he holds his own but once he feels in trouble he forces Latin Lover back in. Diablo & Ueda take advantage and get the pin.

Wagner leaves unfazed. PAC, Goldust & Moss come out to celebrate with their boys but Bull Curry interrupts the show again, causing more chaos in the crowd. The Freaks realize they left Curry without supervision so they all rush to him, with Moss calming him down with more jokes.

Commercial break

The Filthy Animals sans Hamiguchi are interviewed backstage and vow to get revenge for injuring their dear friend, no matter the lengths it will take.

TAKA comes out with Butch Reed and Yuki Iino in his corner, he pumps himself up waiting for Thesz to come out, knowing this is his biggest match in his career.

When Thesz does come out, he is accompanied by the entourage of Lee, Perfect & Rambo, giving them the numbers advantage from the get-go.

Lou Thesz © def. TAKA Michinoku (7:19)

TAKA starts on guns blazing, hitting a flurry of offense on the champ. No one, including TAKA's seconds, can believe how well he is doing to start off. That good start comes to a close swiftly however, as Rambo catches a dive to the outside from TAKA, allowing Thesz to gain control. He slows the contest to a halt. TAKA gets one more burst of energy but Thesz gets a leverage pin for the victory.

Iino & Reed stare down Thesz and co., with Reed getting face to face with the champ. Before anything can get physical between the two, from out of nowhere, Bad Luck Fale comes in and wrecks house, clearing the ring for Lee's despicable legion of men. Now that group has THE UNDERBOSS in the mix.
