

WEEK Weekly #3 - 1/20/2000

Cold open this week sees Top Class standing in the middle of the ring, contract in the hand of Londos. He states that this is for Solar and that if he signs it he will officially become a member of Top Class and receive all the benefits that come with it. He waits a moment but MVP comes out instead. MVP tells the group that Solar is already a part of the Old Synadite and there is no world where he will be leaving the group under any circumstances. He then grabs the contract out of Londos' hands and throws it away into the crowd. MVP gets into Londos' face but Akebono blocks the two. This doesn't stop the Old Syndicate leader though as he tries to attack Akebono. A fight ensues and a ref comes out to make a match between Akebono and MVP official, RIGHT NOW.

Akebono def. MVP (6:13)

The two men jockey for position as the audience is welcomed to the WEEK Weekly with Don West and Jim Ross, the only night of the week where anything can happen.

MVP, despite his use of his BJJ black belt, cannot overcome the sheer size of his opponent and Akebono wins via multiple standing splashes in succession. Londos and Electroshock celebrate with him as MVP leaves disgruntled.

Commercial break

The Freaks are backstage as PAC is making sure Madcap Moss is keeping Bull Curry calm so he and Goldust can prepare for their tag match later on tonight against Cobra and Dragon Lee in peace. Moss assures him that he has Curry under control and that they have nothing to worry about.

Dr. Wagner Jr. def. some Joe Schmo (3:13)

Wagner does Wagner things and wins with the Wagner Driver. He celebrates his quick victory but gets cut-off by Trevor Lee and his entourage.

Wagner gives them a death stare but Thesz waves Wagner off and he leaves begrudgingly.

Lee proclaims that since Thesz defended his belt last week that he does not need to put the title on the line at the PPV, but because Thesz is such a gracious guy he will do a charitable deed and wrestle in the main event in front of, as Lee puts it, a town of EXTREMELY STUPID people, and that he hopes a group with such low IQ levels can understand the rules of a 3 on 3 as Thesz is a big star and won't do a 1 on 1 match so quickly after his last one, his partners will be Perfect and Rambo.

Butch Reed comes out and interrupts Lee and for the 2nd week in a row demands a title shot. Lee says his decision is final and Thesz will not be defending his belt anytime soon. Thesz

grabs the mic out of his hand though and takes measures in his own hands. He doesn't think Reed is on his level but makes the deal that if Reed and his team can beat his team tonight he will THINK ABOUT giving Reed a title shot, Lee swiftly grabs the mic back and says that wouldn't ever happen though. A stare down between Reed and Thesz ensues.

Commercial break

Show cuts backstage to Latin Lover posing for magazines before TAKA Michinoku comes in to make him aware that he will be in the main event tagging with Reed and Yuki Iino. He looks bemused that he has a match again after what happened last week but nonetheless will wrestle in style he says for all his loving fans.

Pre-recorded video plays of Cobra & Dragon with Makabe saying they will get revenge against The Freaks tonight in their match.

The Cobra & Dragon Lee def. Goldust & PAC (15:28)

Cobra & Lee are cornered by Makabe while Goldust & PAC are cornered by Ueda & Diablo.

The Filthy Animals start off fast going to town on Goldust. The pace turns when PAC comes in slowing things down, tagging in and out with Goldy. When the Animals start to get any moment Diablo distracts the ref to allow Ueda to swing his kendo stick through the ropes. Things totally start to break down however when Bull Curry parades out to the ringside with Madcap Moss doing everything in his power to stop him. Curry begins to attack everyone on the outside, no matter which side they are on. The ref tries to get Curry out of there and as the chaos ensues Goldust takes out more magical dust that blinded Animal Hamguchi last week and tries to use it on Dragon Lee. Makabe even after being taken out by Curry, comes into the ring and knocks out Goldust with a lariat with his chain wrapped around him before he could throw the dust. Lee slowly goes for the cover and the ref comes back into the ring in time to make the cover for the Filthy Animals to win.

Commercial break

A vignette plays for 'The Last Disciple of God' Nathan Frazier. He states his Genesis in WEEK will occur next week.

Trevor Lee is backstage on the phone with someone. It is clear that Lee is nervous about whoever he is talking with and says no whoopla will go on during the main event. Lee realizes the camera has been rolling and acts like nothing has happened to bring an announcement. At the PPV, the first ever WEEK tag team titles will be crowned as it will be The Cobra and Dragon Lee vs. El Hijo del Diablo & Umanosuke Ueda. Furthermore Goldust and Gorilla Makabe will also settle their unfinished business at the event as well. Lee says that this is what the fans want and he will always put the fans first.... always.

The camera cuts to PAC yelling at Madcap about what happened with Bull Curry. Moss says he tried everything to stop him but he was going out of control. The whereabouts of Curry are unknown since the ref took care of him.

Thesz, Perfect & Rambo come out with the rest of the entourage looking extra serious on this occasion. Then comes out Reed and lino, they wait for Latin Lover to make his entrance next but he never comes out. Everyone looks confused, even Lee, that is until security camera footage of backstage shows that Latin Lover was seemingly attacked and laid out. Reed and lino are both furious and assume it was the doing of someone from their opposition but they all plead innocence. As all of this is happening, Bad Medicine plays for the second time tonight and Wagner motions to Reed that he wants to replace Latin Lover. Everyone is confused but just go along with Wagner's request not knowing what else to do, especially Lee who does not want any whoopla as he promised there would be none of that.

Commercial Break

Lou Thesz, Mr. Perfect & Rambo def. Butch Reed, Dr. Wagner Jr. & Yuki lino (17:22)

The match is back-and-forth with each team shifting the balance of power throughout. Anytime Thesz and Reed briefly share the ring together, Rambo comes into the ring to get the advantage for his partner. Wagner puts his best foot forward throughout unlike his tag match last week. Trevor Lee stays as out of the action as he can for this match but he doesn't do a good job holding back Fale. lino and Fale get face to face and lino chops him which results in Fale spiking him back in return. The ref is about to cause the DQ but Lee pleads with him not to and he allows for it to continue. lino is knocked out loopy though so Mr. Perfect puts together the pieces and gets the pin for his team.

Reed is understandably furious but Lee is just as concerned not looking to celebrate as is his norm. Before the show can go off the air he gets another phone call. We don't know what or who is calling him but it is clear it's the same man from before. Lee gasps and tells his crew that "He is coming.... next week...."
